1. Confirm what each quote actually includes

2. Photograph and describe the openings

3. Questions worth asking before you sign

☐ What parts of the warranty come from the manufacturer, and what labor is covered?
☐ How will unexpected opening damage be documented and approved?
☐ What payment milestones are tied to ordering, delivery and completion?
☐ Who is my contact if an installation or service question comes up?
